Table 2: Signs of respiratory distress in children with pneumonia

1. Tachypnea

- a. 0 2 months: RR > 60
- b. 2 12 months: RR > 50
- c. 1-5 years: RR > 40
- d. > 5 years: RR > 20
- 2. Dyspnea
- 3. Retractions (subcostal, intercostal and suprasternal)
- 4. Nasal flaring
- 5. Apnea
- 6. Grunting
- 7. Altered mental status
- 8. Pulse oximetry < 90% on room air
