

Table 4: Drug Mechanisms Associated with Syncope

1. Antiarrhythmic drugs:

- QT prolongation (Torsades)
- Vasodilation with orthostasis
- Conduction block
- Sinus node suppression
- Other pro-arrhythmic VT

2. Beta-adrenergic blockers

- Bradyarrhythmia
- Orthostatic hypotension

3. Nitrates / Vasodilators

- Orthostatic hypotension

4. Antibiotics / Antihistamines

- QT prolongation (Torsades)

5. Antidepressants

- QT prolongation (Torsades)
- Orthostatic hypotension
